Dense suggests obtuseness, or an irritating failure to understand quickly or to react intelligently e.g. too dense to take a hint. Slow suggests that the quickness to learn, but not necessarily the capacity for learning, is below average e.g. a pupil slow in most studies. Retarded is applied to those behind others of the same age or class because of mental deficiency e.g. a retarded pupil.
